Preparations are underway for the 43rd Annual Fall festival in Hancock County. We are looking forward to your participation again this year. The festival this year will be Saturday October 5th and Sunday October 6 from 10:00AM until 6:00PM. The fee is only \$45.00 for the 2 day event. As with the previous years there will be no admission charge to the public. We hope this will encourage festival attendees to spend more money at the festival.

The festival is Hancock County's largest event and we are trying to add more things each year. There will be various music and entertainment. We will be having a tractor parade thru the festival grounds.

All vehicles must be removed from the Festival site by 9:30 am. No vender vehicles will be permitted to park on the Festival site (with or without handicap tags or stickers). Booth must be left clean and free of trash. No oil is to be dumped on the festival site.

All food vendors must abide by the rules and regulations of the Tennessee Department of Health. ALL FOOD MUST BE PREPARED ON SITE. There will be a \$35.00 charge for inspection from the Health Department that must be paid Saturday morning in cash.
