

In the early years of Donna Lee's career, Donna had the opportunity to go to Nashville, Tn. and record her first CD. This CD was "Dancing Around It" when it was released it went international and was very successful.

Throughout her career she has performed at schools, churches, weddings, community events, Fourth of July Parade & Firework events as well as special Charity fund raising concerts in Springfield Ma. Often with over two thousand audience members in attendance.

During the last 17 years Donna Lee, has performed before thousands of people traveling with Motor Coach Touring groups which annually come to Vermont and New England from May through November. Recently she returned from Halburton, Ontario where she put on three performances with her Band. This was her second year performing in Ontario.

A video of Donna and her performances has been featured on TNN, currently she is doing an early morning radio program as well as performing "The Patsy Cline" shows. Most recently she and her husband Clark have started a new Donna Lee Entertainers Band near their home in Western Massachusetts. With this group they are performing music from Fleetwood Mac, with Donna Lee impersonating Stevie Nix.

Writing and composing songs and music over the years has been a favorite pastime, she has written and produced three musicals for the New England Motor Coach Touring business. Performing with others for two years in her productions "Country Dreams" and two years with a sequel "The City Slicker Returns". After doing these shows she wrote the script of Patsy Cline's life story called "A Tribute to Patsy Cline, Today, Tomorrow and Forever". Her band performed the music and the vocal accompaniment at that time was performed by the Hammond Brothers, who are from Tennessee they are the "Sons of The Jordanaires", who were the original back-up singers for Patsy Cline and Elvis Presley. More recently another CD has been recorded for more Patsy Cline music. As well as two children's CD's "Bees Go Buzzin", which she recorded several years ago when she did morning relaxation for mothers and their children at several local Massachusetts library's.

Through-out her career Gospel music has been intertwined with her music, Donna Lee has also been known to pick up her guitar and play along while she sings.
